Introduction

In order for worship to be acceptable, it must be offered in spirit and truth (John 4:23-24).

Body

Acceptable worship requires proper remembrance: God's ways (Acts 2:42; 1 Cor. 4:17), God's word (Neh. 1:8-9; 2 Pet. 3:1-2), His deeds (Ps. 77:11-15; 105:1-7), and the death of our Lord Jesus (Luke 22:19-20; 1 Cor. 11:23-26).

Acceptable worship requires proper respect (Lev. 10:1-3; Mal. 1:6-14; 1 Pet. 1:17-19).

Acceptable worship requires proper reflection (Ps. 2:4-12; Prov. 24:30-34; Acts 10:9-23).

Acceptable worship requires proper resolve (Judg. 5:12-15; Acts 11:19-24; 2 Tim. 3:10-17).

Conclusion

Honoring the Lord, let us ascribe unto Him the glory due His name; obeying the Lord, let us worship Him in holy array (Ps. 29:1-2; 96:7-10).
